Ball Machine Rules

- 1. Only adult Greenwich Tennis Club members may use the machine
- 2. Juniors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- 3. The machine is not to be used in wet weather nor with wet balls
- 4. Only the pressureless balls located in the bucket in the cupboard should be used with the machine. Flat balls run risk of jamming the machine
- 5. Never stand in front of machine when on.
- 6. Before returning machine to cupboard, please ensure balls are returned to the bucket from where they came and tip the yellow basket upside down so it fits snugly on top of machine. This should be as you found it! The machine is close to impossible to move and manoeuvre if the balls are contained within the yellow basket whilst wheeling the machine
- 7. Please return the machine to the cupboard after use and note in the logbook your name, the date and time of use PLUS a comment that the machine was working fine or otherwise. If problems arise please phone Janice Gibson 0407906088 or email the Greenwich Tennis Club ASAP.
- 8. Please plug the battery charger into the machine so ready for next person.
- 9. Return the REMOTE to the floor in the front RH corner of the cupboard.
- 10. Remember this is an expensive piece of equipment purchased by the Club for the benefit of ALL members. Please enjoy it and care for it with DUE RESPECT.
